Waste Management Service Guide

Setting up trash and recycling service, refer to community name SIERRA HIGHLANDS COMMUNITY

Service day is Friday. The HOA pays for the basic service, your account set up and linked to the HOA invoice, so they receive the charges. Basic service includes one (1) trash cart and one (1) recycle cart. Cart sizes available 35, 64 or 95 gallon.

Contact 2-3 days prior to your move-in to set-up your address and schedule delivery. Waste Management phone (619)596-5100, email CSSanDiego@WM.com, or by chat "Connect with Us" at WM.COM. The charges need to go to HOA account, do not use the virtual assistant or on-line set-up.



Gray Lid-Trash Only
No household hazardous waste, dead animals, automotive parts, building materials, or large amounts of rock and dirt.



Blue Lid—Recyclables Only
Please do not bag items. Place them loosely in your cart. See reverse for acceptable items.

Service Reminder:

- 1) Place all waste in the appropriate container and close the lid.
- 2) All trash, recyclables, and green waste outside the cart will not be collected.
- 3) Place your carts at the curb by 6:00 a.m. on collection day.
- 4) Roll carts into the street and place them against the curb, handles facing your home. Place carts at least four feet from cars, mailboxes and other obstacles that may prevent Waste Management from servicing your carts.
- 5) Cart placement for service by truck with automated side arm.

Holiday Schedule:

Collection does not occur on the following holidays:

- *New Year's Day*
- *Labor Day*
- *Memorial Day*
- *Independence Day*
- *Thanksgiving Day*
- *Christmas Day*
- When a holiday falls on a weekday, collection will be delayed one day for the remainder of the week. If a holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, there will be no delay in service.

Bulky Item Collection



Collection of large items is available to residents of this HOA community on their regular service day. To schedule a bulky item pick-up, simply contact Waste Management at (619) 596-5100 to

schedule your pick-up at least 48 hours prior to your collection day. A pre-payment will be required.

Acceptable items include: Acceptable bulky items include: furniture, washers, dryers, and toilets.

Non-acceptable items include: Tires, batteries, paint, oil, construction debris, chemicals, rocks, gravel, logs, carpet, hazardous or medical waste.
